

Cross-country Ski Trails Grooming for Success

Government of Canada and City of St. John's invest in Avalon Nordic Ski Club operations in Pippy Park

Today St. John's East MP Nick Whalen, announced a major investment in the Avalon Nordic Ski club. Whalen says the Atlantic Canada Opportunities Agency (ACOA) will give the club \$100,000 towards its snowmaking project at Pippy Park. Mr. Ron Ellsworth, Deputy Mayor of the City of St. John's announced it will invest another \$50,000.

Avalon Nordic will use the money in 2017 to buy snowmaking equipment for Pippy Park's Winter Activity Centre. The equipment will be installed in time for the 2018 ski season.

Avalon Nordic president, Colin Taylor, says climate change has reduced the snow cover at ski facilities around the world. Manufactured snow provides a strong base that will help retain snow cover, extending the ski season on Pippy's approximate 4 kilometres of winter activity trails.

Television personality Andrew Younghusband (Host of Discovery's "Canada's Worst Driver" and "Harder than it Looks") has offered to use his talents to help the club raise any additional funds required. Younghusband learned to ski at Pippy Park. Andrew learned to ski in Pippy Park and credits the sport for his lifelong love of adventure and the outdoors.
