



**NL Cup #3
Avalon Nordic Extravaganza
February 10-12, 2023
Race Notice**

Schedule and Format

A 3-day event from Friday February 10 to Sunday February 12, 2023.

Race #1 – Friday February 10 at the Pippy Park Winter Activity Centre.

20:30: Skate interval start – 3.14 km distance.

20:55: Skate interval start – 0.75 km distance, under 12 youth race.

20:55: Para nordic sit ski race (course distance TBD upon consultation with athletes).

Race #2 – Saturday February 11 at Butter Pot Park.

15:00: Classic mass start – 5.5 km distance.

15:15: Classic mass start – 2.3 km distance, under 12 youth race.

Event #3 – Saturday February 11 in St. John's.

1800-2230: Food, board games, and physical activity social. Details TBA.

Event #4 – Sunday February 12 in Upper Pippy Park.

09:30-11:15: Backcountry classic ski tour (regular nordic classic skis are appropriate – this will be on narrow, packed and groomed, trails in the woods).

Eligibility

All participants are encouraged to be members in good standing with a club recognized by CCNL/Nordiq Canada. Waivers are available for non-members.

Registration and Fees

All ages and genders competing on a common race course will race together. Awards are given in able-bodied, paranordic standing, and paranordic sitting categories. Able bodied results will be broken down by age groups {U12 (ages* 0-11), U14 (ages* 12-13), U16 (ages* 14-15), U18 (ages* 16-17), Senior (ages* 18-29), and Masters (ages* 30+)} and two gender categories {everyone, and women}. Athletes who identify as women are able to indicate so during registration.

** Age is calculated on Dec 31 2022.*

Fees (per race):

- U12 races, 5\$
- All others, 15\$

Online registration is accepted until midnight on February 9. Afterwards, in-person registration is available at the discretion of the race director at double the cost.

There are no trail pass fees for spectators; who are welcome to ski or snowshoe themselves.

This race is part of the NL Cup, a 6-event series held across the province. Your best 4 races count towards an overall NL Points List score < <https://crosscountrynl.com/standings> >. Who will win the season-long competition? After NL Cup #3: Avalon Nordic Extravaganza the following races are:

Important Info

Race #1 is a night races. We recommend wearing a headlamp, although there are also trail lights and significant light pollution from surrounding St. John's (Avalon members regularly ski without assistance).

For Race #2, the stadium is a significant distance (1.3 km, mostly downhill) from the parking and waxing area. Skis or snowshoes are required to access the stadium and/or spectate the race. Walking is not permitted.

Locations

Race #1 – Pippy Park Winter Activity Centre, parking by the North Bank Lodge < <https://goo.gl/maps/vgcyzy1FFxUdkXh8> >. Parking is also available by the Fluvarium and the playground.

Race #2 – Butter Pot Park, parking is available in two locations:

1. Large paved parking lot < <https://goo.gl/maps/6UfDpQJHf621pNmK6> >. This lot is adjacent to the waxing area. It is 1.3 km (mostly downhill) to the stadium.
2. Avalon Nordic clubhouse < <https://goo.gl/maps/LzYkSiYjAi6MRyZaA> >. It is a 2.5 km (flat & downhill) to the stadium.

Event #3 – Social. Will be sent via email to registrants.

Event #4 – Upper Pippy Park Backcountry < <https://goo.gl/maps/ZDAeEkHrxFszRS4MA> >. Parking is also available along Allendale Road (one side, or both sides – as signage indicates).

Waxing Facilities/Waxing Protocol

There is limited waxing infrastructure at Pippy Park. However, the race organizers are pleased to offer complimentary glide waxing with our YesWax kit (takes 2 minutes). Just proceed to the waxing area and a volunteer will take care of it.

There is slightly better waxing infrastructure at Butter Pot Park. An outdoor waxing area will be set up at the park entry kiosk here < <https://goo.gl/maps/LPJaP3ypcZLhmfPX8> >. Again, the race organizers are pleased to offer complimentary glide waxing with our YesWax kit (takes 2 minutes). Just proceed to the waxing area and a volunteer will take care of it. The race organizers will also provide kick wax recommendations and kick wax. However, if clubs can bring extra benches and staff to apply the wax, it would be appreciated. It would help if classic skis are cleaned of old kick wax before you arrive.

*** NOTE: high fluoro glide waxes are NOT permitted. ***
Fluorinated kick wax is permitted.

There is also limited indoor waxing space provided at the Butter Pot clubhouse, but note it is a 2.5 km ski to the stadium.

Awards

For race #1, awards will be presented in the North Bank Lodge at the conclusion of racing.

For race #2, awards will be presented in the stadium at the conclusion of racing.

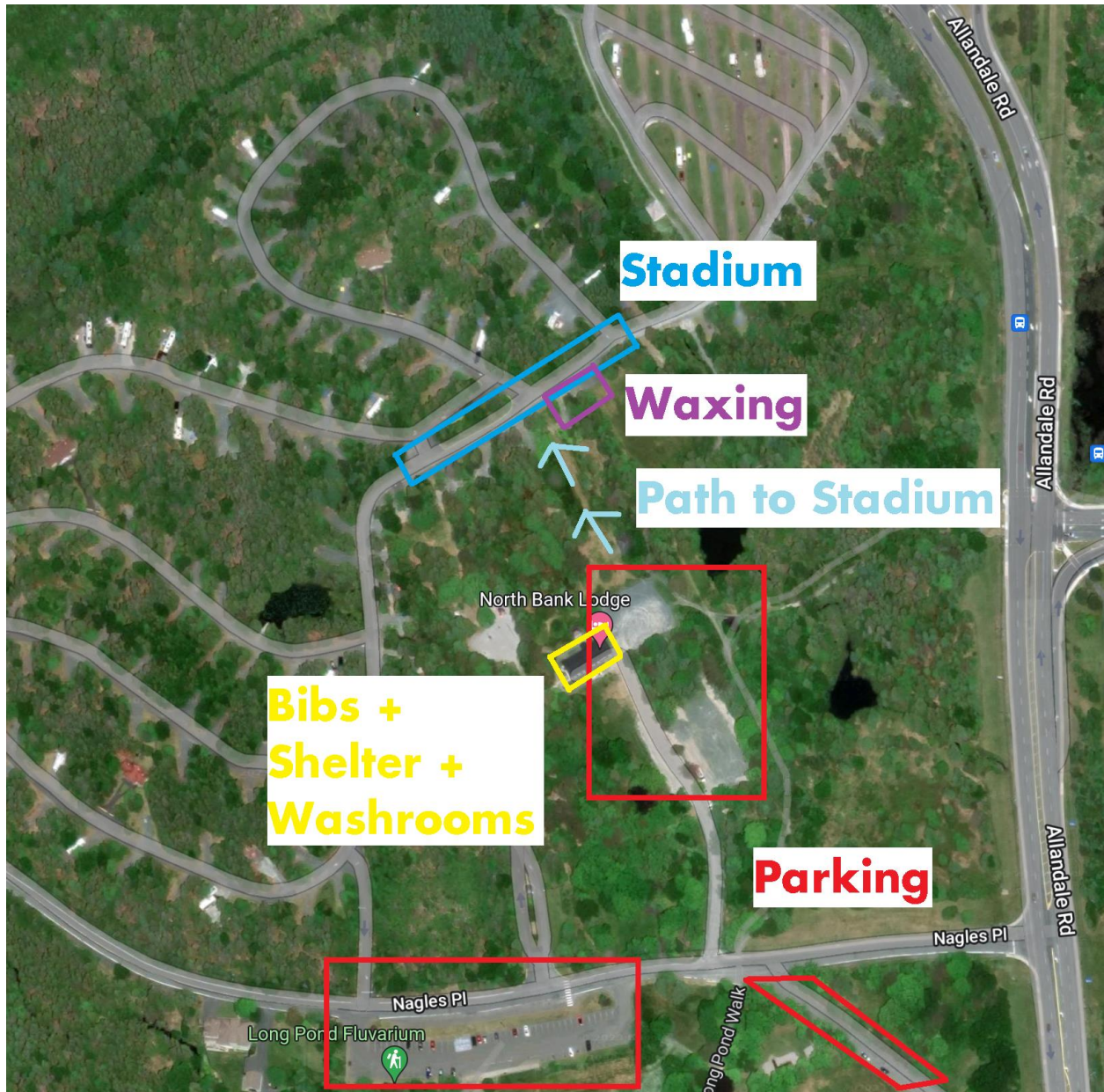
